## RE: Consultation on 2018/2019 budget, APC Fees and Disciplinary levies

The New Zealand Dental Hygienists' Association welcomes the opportunity to comment on the proposed 2018/2019 budget, APC Fees and Disciplinary levies for the Dental Council.

At our NZDHA Executive meeting, we discussed this consultation.

We, the NZDHA Executive, agree on:

- 1. The proposed 2018/2019 Dental Council of New Zealand budget
- 2. All other proposed fees (registration, examination, competence, health accreditation etc...)
- 3. The proposed APC fee for oral health therapists (of whom we have many members with this new scope of practice) of \$663.85 plus GST
- 4. a CPI adjustment equivalent to 2% on all other fees

We also agree on the following for proposed disciplinary levies:

- dental hygienists/orthodontic auxiliaries of \$125.17 plus GST and
- oral health therapists of \$154.19 plus GST

We are however, very concerned that the APC plus disciplinary fee totals (plus GST) for dental hygienists/orthodontic auxiliaries has increased to \$846.53 - an increase of \$209.91. This does not take into consideration that many dental hygienists/orthodontic auxiliaries salaries have not increased as dramatically within this timeframe. Furthermore, many dental hygienists/orthodontic auxiliaries work part-time, yet pay the full APC fees. We have noticed a similar increase in dental therapists fees, the majority of whom work in public practice.
