Q4 Please describe why you support the proposal

I strongly support the removal of the age 18 limit for restorative care from the OHT scope of practice. OHTs are currently treating adult patients so they have the skills to communicate, understand and appropriately care for adult patients. Moreover, OHTs are already doing restorations on the permanent dentition so they have a very good knowledge of different restorations. Therefore, they should be allowed to do restorations on adults because there is no difference in doing a restoration on the permanent tooth of a 17-year-old patient versus a 25-year-old patient.

In addition, currently most New Zealand adults need restorations but they cannot get their treatment done due to the high cost and long waiting list of dentists. Therefore, the removal of the age limit will improve accessibility and possibly reduce the cost of treatment. In turn, this will also improve the oral health status of all New Zealanders.
