## Q4 Please describe why you support the proposal

- -To have a new work force of practitioners able to assess and treat NZer's of all ages is important in the current climate of high dental needs but low levels of people seeking treatment
- -The current registration allows for treatment on permanent dentition for those under 18yr, but the same dentition and treatment required is required for people of all ages (ie a 16MO flg is no different on at 17yr old as it is on a 23yr old, 49yr old or 86 yr old etc) -the additional experience required for treating those older than 18 can easily be taught through a additional course (as demonstrated in other countries, such as Australia)
- A more board scope can provide more career satisfaction and possible slow or stop the 'talent drift' of graduates to Australia
- -Those areas regarding pharma and medical involvement in treatment planning is already considered through an OHT 'hygienist' role and little further education would be required regarding this
