It would be nice to widen my scope of practice. I feel like job satisfaction would be greater if we, as oral health therapists, could actually treat our adult patients restorative needs. Higher job satisfaction would also lead to higher rates of job retention and less migration of Kiwis and therefore better economy. It would also mean that we could provide lower-costing care to lower socio-economic households because patients won't have to go to two different professionals for their oral health. Patients also save time because they won't have to be waitlisted after being referred to a dentist to do work we are capable of.
