STEP BY STEP GUIDE

Tell us your practising intentions for each practising cycle

Notes:

The practising cycle for dentists and dental specialists is 1 October – 30 September each year. The practising cycle for all other oral health practitioners is 1 April – 31 March each year.

This is the form you need to complete **before the start** of each practising cycle to indicate your practising intentions:

- Apply for an annual practising certificate
- Apply to have your name retained on the register (but not practise)
- Apply to have your name removed from the register.

Part way through a practising cycle you can change your practising intentions using the following form and guide:

• Request to change your practising intentions part way through a practising year.

You can access the form to tell us your practising intentions in two ways:

- Access from an email link (page 02 of this document).
- Access from the <u>dashboard</u> of your practitioner portal (page 03 of this document).

Once you have started an application, you can save it and it will then appear on your 'In progress' list of applications.

You can return to a form and make changes at any time.

Once you have completed and submitted a form, it will appear on your 'Completed' list of applications (with a PDF file you can download) and remain there for your future reference.

Step 01: Email message

You will receive an **email message** from the Dental Council shortly before the start of your annual practising cycle each year.

Open the email and click the 'practitioner portal' link.
